### Norovirus

We have been informed by WCC that cases of norovirus are high. Norovirus is highly infectious and is easily spread through contact with someone with the infection or with contaminated surfaces. Full recovery usually takes 2 to 3 days. It is important to drink plenty of fluids to prevent dehydration. Some simple steps can be taken to help prevent the spread of the virus, these include:

Regular handwashing with soap and water. Alcohol gel does not kill off norovirus

Stay at home if norovirus symptoms are experienced Do not return to school or work until 48 hours after symptoms have cleared

### Anti-Idling Campaign

Our Eco Council are taking action and have started an Anti-Idling Campaign! What is Idling?

- Idling is when a vehicle's engine is on, but the vehicle is not moving.
- It happens when a vehicle is waiting in traffic or when a car is waiting for a shorter period of time at a parking spot or when pulled over on the side of the road.
- It can lead to higher levels of air pollution in and around the school!

On Tuesday 28th March from 3pm, some children from Eco council will be found in the Key Stage Two playground handing out leaflets about idling and asking parents/careers to sign our anti idling pledges! We hope to see you there.
