#### Walk to School Week:

We are joining in with the National Walk to School Week form 15<sup>th</sup>-19<sup>th</sup> May. This is a five-day challenge where we encourage children to walk, scoot or ride to school, rather than coming to school in a car. If children live a long way from the school, we encourage parents to park a distance away from the school so that the children walk part of their journey. Through this challenge, children will be well on their way to reaching their recommended 60 minutes minimum of physical activity per day before even reaching the school gates! Class teachers will be tallying up the methods of transport each day.
