Phonics


We have introduced the graphemes v, w, x, y. We have been spending a lot of time recognising our **tricky words**. The children are taught to recognise these by sight as normal phonic rules do not apply. We look for them when we are reading and identify them before we read a page. The words this week have been **and**, **has**, **his and her**.

Reading

The children are continuing to make great progress with their segmenting and blending while reading. Please ensure you are reading regularly at home a least 3 times a week. Every Friday we will check reading diaries and children who have read on 3 different days on the week will get a sticker. Children can get more stickers for more reading. Please make sure <u>yellow reading diaries</u> are in school every day so we can record when they read with us.

Mathematics

This week the children have been continuing to explore 2D shapes through exploring and creating pictures made up of simple shapes. We have also been exploring sequencing events including what events happen at night and during the day. The children have learned time vocabulary including: Morning, afternoon, evening and night.





By now you should have received information on how to request tickets for our performance as well as information on which role your child has in the production. The children voted for their roles in the Christmas play. If you have not received either of these then please let us know ASAP so we can get the relevant information out to you.


Down to the bottom of the volcano and back up to the top
