Phonics

We have been spending the week consolidating all the phonics skills we have taught this term. The children have been using their segmenting fingers to identify sounds in words, and have been writing them down on their white boards with many children forming letters with beautiful accuracy.

Reading

Mathematics

In Maths this week, we have been exploring sequencing language including: first, next and last and applying these words to everyday routines and tasks such as brushing your teeth and making breakfast. Next week, we will be assessing the children on the key skills and knowledge we have explored this term.
