# Friday 17th May



This week we have continued our dinosaur theme by looking at Harry and the Bucketful of Dinosaurs. The children have really impressed us with their imaginative writing this week. It's great to see so many children so confidently applying their phonics with more independent writing.

#### **Phonics**

This week we have focused on revising tricky words. These form a really important element of early reading and we want our children to be as confident reading and spelling as many of these words ready for Year 1. We teach the children to talk about which parts are trying to trick us out. We have attached all of the learned tricky words for you to discuss at home together.

### Reading

Please can you make sure that your child has their yellow reading diary in school every day so we can record if they read in class. Please ensure Yellow books and reading books are always in on a Friday as this is our changeover day.

**Maths** We have been developing our understanding of adding and subtracting this week in maths. The children are really strengthening their understanding of numbers to 10. Next week we are exploring the properties and uses of shapes.
