We have had another fun week exploring traditional tales learning all about the naughty Goldilocks and her visit to the three bears' house. Our tale for next week is The 3 Little Pigs.

We have been so impressed with the enthusiasm for more independent writing in class and the children are really sharpening their skills ready for Year 1.



Phonics

There has been some excellent reading and spelling in Phonics this week, the children are reading and spelling complex words with relative ease and fluency. We will be introducing words ending in 'ing' and 'ed' next week.

Many of the children are really strong when reading the tricky words, but less so with writing them. Playing games such as Hangman at home can really help with developing their awareness of spelling tricky words. A list is attached. The children are taught to know how to read and write these without sounding and blending them.

Next week!

Monday - both classes will be taking park in a gymnastics festival in the morning as part of sports week. Please can all children come to school on Monday in P.E. kit.

Thursday - both classes are taking part in our EYFS Sports Day. We would like to start at 2pm so if you are able to attend, please wait in the main office area from 1:50. Both classes this week have had their final Balanceability lessons. We are so proud of everyone for showing such determination and resilience and our instructors have been so impressed with the children's enthusiasm. We hope all of the children continue enjoying riding their bikes!

Here is a full list of the **tricky words** taught his year. We teach the children that these should not be blended when reading.

We are also encouraging them to spell these words correctly when writing, with other writing we look for it to be phonetically plausible eg <u>castle</u> could be spelt as 'casul' and princess might be 'prinses'.
