Phonics

We have looked at words ending in 'ing' and 'ed' this week, and revisited tricky words we have seen before.

Maths

In Maths we have revisited number bonds of numbers up to 10. Number bonds are pairs of numbers that add together to make your target number. E.G. 2 and 3 are a number bond pair for the number 5. It's really important for children to be able to recall as many number bonds as possible as these facts are so useful for their maths in year 1.
